
Conclusion of the Intellectual Output 3 "SINTRA e-Learning Platform"

The Greek partner — APOPSI SA — concluded the project's e-learning platform that will support the pilot trainings in all partners' countries and will provide the training resources, developed within the project to targeted and interested end-users during the project's duration and in the long-run.

The Platform includes the following SCORM e-Learning courses in English and in all partners' languages:

- ⇒ Understanding the organisational context and its potential for sustainability-oriented development.
- ⇒ Assessing one's own potential to innovate and add "sustainability value".
- ⇒ Identification of sustainability-focused innovation opportunities and prospects using internal and external sources of ideas.
- ⇒ Provisional assessment of intrapreneurial initiatives' sustainability impact.
- ⇒ Defending the merits of ones' intrapreneurial ideas and working with the organisation's management on sustainability issues.
- ⇒ Formation and operation of intra-organisational intrapreneurship teams for sustainability-focused development.

SINTRA partnership transnational meetings

On 27 & 28 September 2021 the 3rd transnational project meeting was held where the partnership disscussed about the produced training materials, pilot workshops, e-learning platform, counseling services as well administration and management issues. The meeting was held in Croatia, organized by VE-GO-RA and had a hybrid form with participating partners physically and online through MS Teams.



The 4th transnational meeting of SINTRA project took place on 11-12 January 2022 in Aveiro, Portugal. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, only the Bulgarian, Croatian and Icelandic partners attended the meeting in person, while the other partners participated via TEAMS.

The results achieved so far and the future developments of the project were discussed, namely the pilot trainings on sustainability-focused intrapreneurship support as well as the counselling services to be provided to organizations in the partner countries.
